February 26, 2013 we will welcome the amazing magic of FISM winning card magician, Gregory Wilson, a local guy who has made it big in magic. Gregory Wilson has lectured and performed workshops for Ring 313 on several occasions. This visit will give you some new ideas that he has created for his upcoming European Tour. Wilson will be presenting a hand's on workshop immediately before the lecture, contact Todd Reis for details (714) 673-7320.

March 26, 2013 meeting will feature a lecture from the famous "Magic Smith." Chris Smith. Known to many performers as Magic Smith, he served as President of IBM Ring 313 in 1998. He is visiting us from his new home in Las Vegas, Nevada to demonstrate how he develops ideas into performance winners. Bring your own magic ideas to show how you can produce magic using ordinary objects.

April 30, 2013 has a very special performer from Texas, Mr. Richard Turner. Turner is regarded by many as the best card magician alive today. He serves as a consultant to the U.S. Playing Card Company to help them develop playing cards that meet the demanding standards of magicians and professional card players. We are honored to host this special lecture from a master of the pasteboards.

May 28, 2013 we will continue our tradition of hosting a pasteboards sleight-of-hand practice session. Members will demonstrate to each other favorite methods of manipulating playing cards to the amazement and delight of audiences young and old. SHOOT OGAWA Dazzels

was the first meeting of the Ring for this year. We were fortunate to start the year with one of the top performers in the world, Mr. Shoot Ogawa. He began by performing some of his awarding winning routines using playing cards, coins, and ropes. After dazzling the members with his effects, Ogawa painstakingly described the methods he used to create the magic. Ogawa's methods are sensible and practical; in his hands, they are diabolical. He described a four coin production effect where each coin was produced using a different principal thwarting any spectators attempt to discover his methods. Members eagerly questioned Ogawa to get detailed explanation of angles, sleights, and special handling of coins, ropes, or pasteboards. Everyone was pleased with Ogawa's responses. Guests and members left the meeting with big smiles on their faces. Ogawa's lecture is highly recommended.
