

Barry Matas Magical Tips Discover Mysterious Mesmer's Mansion on Facebook



Mesmer's Mansion is an exclusive community of mentalists and bizarre magicians on Facebook. Nestled back among the dead pines, amidst gray skies is a decaying mansion. Paint peeling from the clapboard panels. Within these hallowed precincts, wizards gather. These trusty souls exchange valuable, and often dangerous of all things . . .IDEAS.

We are dedicated to share fellowship, friendship, and ideas about mentalism and bizarre magic/magick entertainment. No noses in the air, just down to earth fun and frolic, beer to cognac exchange in the foyer. Be careful of the steps to the mansion . . .there are some loose floorboards, outside. . . and in Mesmer's Mansion.

Mesmer's Mansion is a metaphor of a virtual space populated with many rooms. There is of course a library, archives, and a séance gallery. Our archives are secreted in dusty basements located deep

within the bowels of the mansion. They are protected by Clive, our far-sighted archivist. Slate-switchers and finger-flinging mediums work their magick in our séance gallery.

Christopher Faria is the founder of Mesmer's Mansion. Faria possesses a Doctor of Divinity and PhD in Christian Intellectual Thought. Dr. Faria has performed internationally. Today he resides in Colorado Springs, CO, where he performs as a mentalist and comedy hypnotist.

Faria was introduced to mentalism when he was seventeen years old by Doc Monte. Doc Monte was a carnival worker who spent his entire life working county and state fairs. Monte learned his craft as a mentalist and hypnotist in the trenches of the backwaters of America. Faria met Monte in a little bookstore in Stockton, California. Doc tested young Faria's commitment to learn the art while observing him participating in charitable work. After a performance in Los Angeles for inner city children, Doc finally agreed to become young Faria's



magic mentor. This training continued for several decades.

After a stint in the United States Army, Faria became a member of the Psychic Entertainer's Association under his stage name of Jonathan David. Faria began to publish some of his favorite effects including: The Dark Card, Walk of Fame, and two Linking Ring One Man-Parades. Faria maintains he is the great-unknown mentalist. "My main career was as an Army Chaplain. Mentalism and magic paid for college and seminary. I performed my comedy hypnosis show in Iraq for the soldiers, and in the middle of one of them, we came under fire. That was an experience."

"Mentalism takes one to dark presentations sometimes and that's fine. Most magicians that I have met in Mesmer's Mansion enjoy horror movies as I do. I'm constantly on the search for ideas and presentations that take my audiences to the edge of what I call the "what if?" My "Unusual Suspects," a tale about the Jack the Ripper Suspects, or my "Shadow Man," which was just published in the British Society of Mystery Entertainers journal,

Psycrets are just that, a way of taking an audience to the brink of the entertaining question,

"what if?" Members in the Mansion contribute their effects to the Archives in the Mansion. The Archives are chock full of effects, essays, video tutorials, permissions of which we have been granted by their creators."

Dr. Faria explains that the Facebook page, Mesmer's Mansion, is "a place for all the mentalists I'd met through Facebook where we could freely exchange ideas, effects, and moreover, fellowship. Real friendships inasmuch as that is possible. I learned how to keep an electronic community positive as one of the co-directors of Surplus Magic Exchange. Mentalists, tend to be loners. We eschew the finger flinging, though many of us spent our earlier years honing those skills, as I did, learning bottom



dealing, second dealing, palming, etc. We tend to draw into ourselves and we need a place to explore ideas, storytelling, methods, and more over the relationships that contribute to all of that.

Mentalists and bizarre magicians are invited to join Mesmer's Mansion on Facebook. There is an entrance exam. Prospective members of this Facebook group must correctly answer questions that will be reviewed by the group's moderator. Not everyone who asks will be permitted to join. Members must prove they possess basic knowledge of mentalism magic. **By Barry Matas**

The Magnificient Seven



Donald Merritt Desfor July 5, 1927 - March 29, 2015

Donald Merritt Desfor was born on July 5, 1927 to Jeanette and Irving Desfor of Queens, New York. His passion-filled life included a wide array of interests but none surpassed his love of magic, tennis, and photography. Each and every aspect of his life was infused with his sharp wit and unique sense of humor.

While in high school, Don worked with 'Doc' Abe Hurwitz for the city of New York performing at parks and hospitals throughout the five Burroughs of the city. He was inducted into the parent assembly number 1 with Howie Swartzman around 1944 but then left for the service where

he toured the Pacific Islands in an all navy show called "Anchor Antics".

One of his early innovations was handkerchief juggling. His doctorate PHD was in visual perception and the use of photographs in therapy. He and his father, Irving, performed the only father son act know as "The Desfor Brothers". Don was an official photographer with his father at conventions. Don was a lifetime member of the Magic Castle. Over the last twenty years he was known among his Malibu beach community as "The Magic Man". He continued to entertain them, his family, and more than a few strangers with his magic tricks.


