On Tuesday, April 27, 2010, twenty Ring members gathered for A Night of Impromptu Magic. Members were asked to bring pocket tricks they carry with them at all times. Chris Wynkoop demonstrated a version of "Torn and Restored cocktail napkins." Kevin Brown followed with a mentalist effect using ordinary coins. John Fedko stepped forward to show a visual playing card effect he first published and sold in the 1970's called "Exchango," a packet trick that appeared for sale in M-U-M, The Linking Ring, and Harry Lorayne's Apocalypse. The effect is similar to Oil and Water but uses a special sleight, "Fedko's Finesse," that makes it different from the standard Oil and Water illusion. Daytona Magic has this effect for sale.

Roy Ball brought four effects to mystify and entertain our members. He used a deck of playing cards to produce an effect where a chosen card was located and then used to find the four aces. Finally, he used the spectator's name in a spelling routine to locate the chosen card

Past President Todd Reis, using a borrowed a deck of cards to verify three "predictions" Todd had made. Next up, Kevin Brown performed several coin miracles with coins separating and then recombining at his discretion. Former member Ryan Schell performed an "ambitious card routine" that he learned from the Klutz Book of Magic.

A first time visitor to our Ring, a magician we only know as "Guy," performed a version of Dai Vernon's ten count routine using plastic frogs. Guy then performed a Paul Harris effect with a signed card, lost and relocated, to discover that the spectator had signed the front and back of the selected card. John Fedko demonstrated a three-phase coins across effect using three borrowed coins. Kevin Brown closed the evening's Im-
