An Evening of Impromptu Magic at IBM Ring 313

On Tuesday, July 30, 2013, thirty members and guests of the John Fedko Ring gathered to demonstrate some of their favorite magical illusions that can be performed without special preparations. President Chris Wynkoop started the parade of effects showing his bar napkin routines and a demonstration using an adding machine (Chris's day job is CPA, he is always using calculators). Chris started a parade of effects mostly using everyday objects one may find in a restaurant, office, or home. Of course some effects were performed with an ordinary deck of playing cards. Members performing included: Steve Longacre (iPhone APP, and Magic for Dummies trick), Ray Karch (coins across with seven coins); Kevin Brown (Penny, nickel, dime; two fingers; and a coin moving uphill on a rubber band).

Also stepping forward were Victor Cohn (Ben's mother had three children, she named her first Penny, her second daughter Nicole, what is the name of her third child?); Ray Karch showed how to make a rose from a cocktail napkin; Robert Propper showed coins across using the Goshman's pinch, then performed sugar cubes across using napkins. Next up James Hjorth performed iPAD magic; Kevin Brown returned with a Card to Phone effect using an IPhone APP; then Todd Reis took the floor using the Elmsley Count with cocktail coasters.

Cornelius Wilson used his hat to make a coin disappear and reappear using an invisible hook; Sammy Ruiz performed a dazzling trick with a prepared deck; Zeezo (aka Larry Campbell) used the paddle move with his color changing knives; Todd Reis stepped up again with a few pasteboard miracles and Cornelius closed the evening with two of his "lazy favorites" card miracles. Wow! We enjoyed entertaining each other.
