October 25: Member's Performance Night: Halloween Magic: Kevin Brown, served as Master of Ceremonies for the evening's performances. Brown began the festivities by telling us a story about his grandmother, who was in her day, a psychic of some note. Jay Leslie stepped forward as the second performer to show us how the hand is quicker than the mind. Leslie produced a half dollar coin in his hand, then passing both hands behind his back, asked when he brought them out again for a spectator to guess which hand held the coin. Gary Meier demonstrated his ability to determine whether a volunteer was telling the truth or lying. Next on stage was *Philip Henderson*. Henderson showed a card trick from last year's Linking Ring, demonstrating a Harry Lorayne illusion. John Fedko followed with a demonstration of one solid passing through another solid. Fedko passed a wooden spike through solid glass windowpane without breaking the glass. Kevin Brown regained center stage was able to levitate the table to the surprise and amazement of the spectators. Jim "Cardman" Greene demonstrated another effect that uses the famous ESP card deck. Cardman made a series of predictions using the ESP deck and was correct on every demonstration. *Ted "SUDS" Subdrack* poured himself on stage to show us his "trained tarantula." The spooky eight-legged critter correctly identified a randomly selected card. Roy Ball showed how JUMBO cards can be manipulated to S-P-E-L-L real magic on stage. Michael van Horn's has been working on a presentation honoring the work of Eugene Burger. The lighting in the room was altered and a scene established to make a very spooky presentation of Card Warp where the magic occurs mostly in the mind of the spectators as van Horn pulled us into his magical story about a Queen in trouble. John Fedko returned to the stage to show a version of 3 Card Monte using JUMBO cards. Master's of Ceremonies Kevin Brown closed the evening with a mystery of a borrowed finger ring disappearing before being discovered inside a box that was found inside a bag. Thanks to all the members who participated as spectators and magicians on this special performance night. Very spooky effects tonight.
