August 27, 2013 Ring 313 Auctions. If you have an interesting magical effect that you want to sell for top-dollar, bring them to the Auction on August 27th. Ring 313 will retain 50 percent of the sale price to use for future lecturers, you will set the minimum price to assure you get full value for your treasure. For example, if you possess an item you purchased 20 years ago for \$500 dollars, you can set the minimum bid at \$400 thus assuring yourself \$200 or you get to keep the item.
