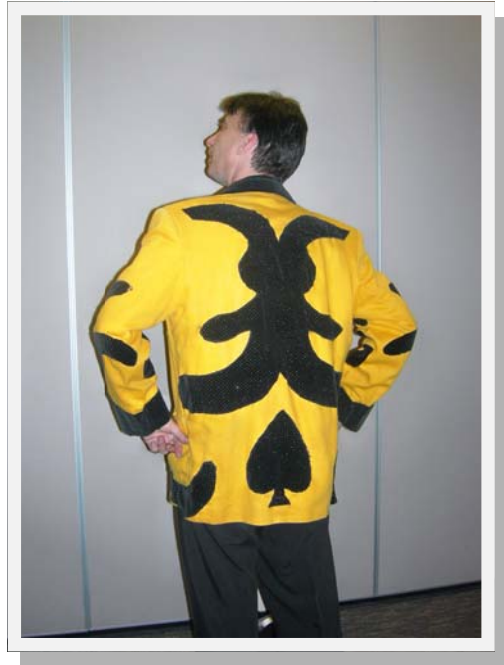


PAST EVENTS
