mat is a Magicia

A magician, called by another name, is still a magician. Among performers who qualify as magician are Juggler, Clown, Mime, Sorcerer, Balloon artist, Puppeteer, Street magician, Grifter, Jester, Grand Illusionist, Parlour entertainer, Mentalist, Conjurer, Houdini, Escape Artist, Necromancer, and actors. When you call someone a genius, you might refer to the person as an "Einstein," likewise when you call someone a magician, often someone calls you a "Houdini."

What these performers have in common is they practice an art form that requires years of study to perfect so they can demonstrate to the public simple and complex acts that appear to be opposed to some of the natural laws of science. Magicians appear to make one object turn into another object. Magicians appear to make one object move from a known position into an unlikely unknown position (card to lemon). Magicians appear to pull solid items from empty space and then with the full attention of the audience, returns those items to the ether from whence they came.

To earn the appellation magician, a performer must study diligently, usually with a mentor to guide the way. The study includes countless hours of practice before live audiences. Until the performer has experienced repeated trouble with his hands, his mind, his practical tools, and his audience, he is not prepared to entertain. Having all the issues that could ruin your performance occurring repeatedly, the magician is now prepared to handle these obstacles with grace, magnificence, and cleverness. Merely following the steps in a packet trick is not yet magic. We aspire to earn the designation magician because our work is sublimely entertaining . . . and somewhat convincing. If you believe your magic is real, your audience may go along with you.

Remembering John Calvert



Ring 313 was fortunate to host lectures from John Calvert and Tammy in April 1999 and again in January 2009 at age 97. John was born on August 5, 1911 and left the stage for the last time on September 27, 2013 with more than 100 years of magic in between. His legacy guides all who desire a life devoted to entertainment.

After the meeting in April 1999, I guided John and Tammy to their hotel room located at the La Quinta Inn on Sand Canyon, merely a half mile away. He drove a large truck that was pulling a twenty- foot long travel trailer. John deftly backed the vehicle and trailer in the dark, into the only space in the parking lot that would fit his rig. As far as I was concerned, parking that rig in the dark was his largest magic act of the evening. He was 97 years young! Stepping down from the truck, he offered to shake my hand. I discovered that my own large hand was lost in his enormous mitt. His powerful grip was surprising too. John was 97 years young, strong at heart and strong in body. John Calvert proved that one can live to enjoy a century of

magic. What a life he enjoyed. Thank you John and Tammy!
