What's in a name? It's always amazed me that attendance is higher when a lecturer is better known. The truth is that we are fortunate enough to be in one of the two US regions where great magicians live but unless you developed a household name like Scott Boeger (Worlds greatest escape artist), Dick Berry or SUDS, most are relatively unknown (including myself).

Most famous magicians initially had sponsorship that took them from being obscure to being stars. My point is that just because someone's name isn't familiar to you, that shouldn't make you apprehensive from attending the lecture. Take for example Tim Mannix who was well received yet very few of you knew him before his appearance and our last lecturer Phil Van Tee, enough said.

I believe that skill is more important than notoriety and experience is more important than "who's hot." Different performers use similar effects differently. We can expand our repertory by closing observing the differences that can inspire our own routines. Therefore, in the coming year, my goal is to have a variety of lecturers who have talent, whether they are well known or not. The next time we have a lecturer you've never heard of, get up from your couch and come to the meeting. If you don't attend all we can say is, you have no idea what you missed.

John received a six-hour chemo treatment, the first of five scheduled sessions, on Friday, December 23, 2011, at a local hospital. Doctors told John that he should expect at least three months at home to recover from the illness and the chemotherapy. John's wife *Catherine* is a nurse. She is caring for him, with the help of a daughter and two-granddaughters. Remember that Cathy has her own medical challenges with diabetes, among other ailments. I spoke with John on Thursday, December 22, 2011. He asked me to tell the members of Ring 313 that he is fighting this cancer and

Triny Peller (February 2, 1919-December 22, 2011)

"IBM Ring 313 mourns the death of long-time member Triny Peller, widow of Albert Peller. Triny and Al were fixtures in the Los Angeles area, generously and passionately supporting the art of magic in many venues.

Triny was born Catherine Bichler in Luxembourg. She met Albert Peller when she was a translator at the Nuremberg War Trials and he was an American US Army attorney. Both Triny and Albert were graduates of the Chavez School of Magic. Triny was a generous patron of the Art of Magic. The Society of American Magicians, the International Brotherhood of Magicians, the Magic Castle and many local magic clubs and magicians were recipients of her generosity. Triny donated the money for the Peller theater at the Magic Castle in Albert's memory.

Triny had been living under the exceptional care of "Granny's Place" in Mission Viejo for some time, and as a final act of good will to benefit others, she asked that her body be donated to the USC School of Medicine for research to benefit the health and well-being of those who follow. Triny passed

away on December 22, and is survived by a sister and nephew living in Germany."

Triny Peller was a good friend to Ring 313. She sponsored our contests; donated and purchased books for our library and helped the Ring get its financial footing in the early days of the Ring. She continued to be supportive of the activities of young magicians despite her illnesses.

I, Philip Henderson, will remember Triny Peller as the lovely woman with an angelic smile and a slight European accent. She usually sat in the back of the room. Her friendly presence encouraged the members of Ring 313 to become excellent magicians. She was a graceful woman of the old school.
