On Tuesday, May 24, 2011, seventy plus Ring members and guests assembled for our regular monthly



meeting. President Leslie reminded members of the upcoming Annual Picnic on July 9, 2011 at our new location, Taft Elementary School in Santa Ana. Leslie asked volunteers to sign up to work the "Day of Magic" at the Orange County Fair on July 30, 2011. Ring members are needed to assist with the Future Magician's contest and the following Magic Workshop. Members who volunteer will receive free admission and free park-

ing at the OC Fair for the day. President Leslie introduced the evening's lecturers Rachel and

Aldo Colombini. The Colombini's presented some of their newest magical effects as part of their Farewell Lecture Tour. Explanation, this is the last time Aldo and Rachel plan to tour as lecturers. Nonetheless, they plan to attend local magic conventions and will be available to lecture when in the locale. As Aldo noted, "We are not retiring . . . we are magicians! for a paying audience. Aldo reminded us that as magicians, the product you sell to the audience YOURSELF, not the effect. Ra and Aldo encouraged us to demo strate to the audience that you en what you do. Remember, MAG

The Colombini's brought a variety of new magical effects to demonstrate to the Ring. The best part of their lecture was experiencing first hand their love for magic. While the members of the Ring were laughing at the Colombini's sight gags and illusions, it was clear that no one was having more fun than Rachel and Aldo. Their personal enthusi-

asm is contagious. Aldo and Rachel showed us magical effects that are within the reach of anyone serious about performing magic illusions for the public. The Colombini's presented strong magical tricks using playing cards, ropes, and other common objects. They completed the evening with Rachel Colombini performing a cups and balls routine inspired by an effect Aldo performed in FISM's XIII World Championship of Magic in Vienna, held in 1976. Aldo Colombini won 2nd place in micromagic

with that performance.

Aldo and Rachel make their living as full-time magicians. Aldo remarked how blessed he feels to be able to perform magic effects

for a paying audience. Aldo reminded us that as magicians, the product you sell to the audience is YOURSELF, not the effect. Rachel and Aldo encouraged us to demonstrate to the audience that you enjoy what you do. Remember, MAGIC for the audience is about the entertainment they experience, not the methods that you use. Rachel and Aldo love being magicians, this was evident on their arrival, during the course of the lecture, and late into the evening, as they remained to pose for photographs or to explain details of the effects they per-



formed. If you have an opportunity to spend a day or evening with the Colombini's consider it a wise investment . . . their work is pure magic!
